Uganda took in more than one million refugees in its northern vast deserted plain. The United Nations has been their primary provider. However, at present, it appears to be harder even for the United Nations.

Some charitable organizations also participate in the rescue. Praise the Lord! He set aside a spot for us. In the name of the Host Charity, our service goals involve: 1. Teaching the refugees to plant mulberry trees and raise silkworms to make a living.

2. Establish tent-weaving churches (About 300 have been established) 3. Youth ministry. 4. Mercy ministry. As for the Youth ministry, we provide opportunities for the young people to play football! (They used to play with stones with bare feet!) We have planned to train about a hundred local refugee co-workers who evangelize in the refugee camps, and some of them have become the chaplain and coach of the football team. We trust that the Lord will raise up these young people.

We are the co-workers of Jehovah's host (the Host in short). Over the years, God has led us to share missionary information in churches in North America.
